Ten years ago 3 college students arrived in Mettu, Ethiopia to teach English to a crowd of 1,200 students climbing the walls to come to English classes. Today the classes are smaller but the need is even more important. Ethiopian students have to take all their classes in English after 10th grade if they are to continue in school. Learning English is matter of economic survival.

The ESL program is a 4 week program that targets students who have a chance to pass the national exam. It is a program that demonstrates that Presbyterians care enough to give their time, skills, compassion, and money to help in a concrete way the future citizens of Ethiopia.
