DIRECTIONS TO MASSANETTA SPRINGS CONFERENCE CENTER

If you are coming from the Shenandoah Valley, take Exit 274A from I-81 onto Route 33 East. Go to the 7th stoplight (about 2.5 miles) and turn right on the Massanetta Springs Road (Route 687). The main parking lot for the conference center is approximately a half-mile on the right. (Look for the stone wall on the right. If you have passed the flashing light, you have gone too far.)

If you are coming from east on the Blue Ridge Mountains, take US 29 to Ruckersville. Turn west onto Route 33. Follow Route 33 west for almost 34 miles. Turn left onto Massanetta Springs Road (Route 687). The main parking lot for the conference center is approximately a half-mile on the right.

Spring is an especially beautiful time to visit the grounds of Massanetta Springs. The historic hotel has a veranda with rocking chairs. This is an ideal spot to sit and enjoy the colors, smells, and fresh air of Massanetta's grounds.

Helpful information: Dress is casual and comfortable. A golf cart will assist with on-campus transportation as needed.
